- 1. Students begin with the DynaNotes content student-friendly, comprehensive coverage of the eligible TEKS

 - 3. At home

- c. Sharing Notes good, helpful notes go viral
 - i. Small group activity focus on one section of content
 - 1. Present your favorite note to small group
 - 2. Describe why you chose it
 - 3. Others can copy it (type or photo of photo note)
 - 4. Vote for best note in the small group
 - 5. Winner chooses who, of the small group, will present that favorite note to the rest of the class
- d. Student maintains control over his/her notes ... each student must choose to add each note → ownership, pride, and the "IKEA effect" (see Dan Ariely's TED Talk on the psychology of effort)
- 3. Other features of *DynaNotes Plus*
 - a. Links to helpful 3rd party websites
 - i. Exploration/extension
 - ii. Assignment
 - iii. Flip lessons
 - b. Total *DNP* App Usage data
 - i. From home page or by email/website request for an Excel-based report (email login details to appsupport@dynanotes.com)
- 4. New features in *DNP* version 3.0
 - a. Supports multi-user functionality for a tablet that is used by more than one student, such as classroom sets of iPads -- will enable password protected note sets ... "add a user" ... so that only Sam can see and edit Sam's notes
